International policy co-operation

- International policy cooperation is key in work on JREF-objectives
- Many global and regional organizations address similar RE issues
- Some of them are dealing with the policychallenges of DEPLOYMENT of renewables
- International RE organizations must collaborate creating synergies and avoid duplication



International Energy Agency IEA

- 28 members from OECD countries
- Addressing all types of energy issues
- Historically prioritization on conventional energy sources (oil, gas and nuclear)
- Lately (limited but) increased focus on RE in the organization, RED
- The need for "an energy revolution"
 - is not really reflected in the work program, budget nor ministerial agenda
- The recent developments in Japan and Germany- increased focus on RE in IEA?



International Energy Agency IEA

- WEO global energy scenarios guiding governments RE – policy decisions
- WEO RE-assessments have improved
 - <u>but there is still need for a fundamental</u> <u>reassessment of the potential of RE</u> (Bonn, RETd and IRENA, 2011)
- Reassesment of
 - Prices for fossil energy and RE,
 - PV and Wind growth rates,
 - Savings from reduced adaptation-, volatilityand security costs



IEA - RE related activities

- REWP-RED –new focus on
- Markets and systems
 - From analysis to action(short term actions incl.) on markets and systems
 - A "market roadmap" for the next 5 years?
 - Close co-operation with industry RIAB to define most important barriers
- Technology roadmaps
- R and D, implementing agreements

- technology and market cross cutting IA with
- focus on assessing barriers and solutions for RE
- THE REASSESSMENT OF RE(IN PARTNERSHIP)?
- accelerated RE deployment.
- scenarios and other deployment barriers
- Close co-operation within IEA and other IO's. IRENA and JREF invited to be members
- Hosting workshops upcoming expert workshop on priorities for RE deployment 10.11.11 in Berlin
- Planned ministerial event spring 2012
