The Powering Past Coal Alliance (PPCA)

- Voluntary government-driven alliance of governments and organizations;
- Response to environmental, economic, and health impacts of unabated coal power;
- 64 Partners (28 countries, 8 subnational governments, and 28 businesses and organizations);
- Partners commitments:
 - Governments:

Phasing-out existing unabated coal power within their jurisdictions **and** a moratorium on new unabated coal power stations;

Businesses:

Powering operations without coal;

All:

Supporting clean power through policies; Reducing finance for unabated coal power stations without operational CCS.



Countries moving toward low-carbon, climate-resilient economies are already seeing environmental, economic, and human-health benefits. Our coalition want to help accelerate that treatition.

Powering hast Coal brings together a diverse range of governments, businesses, and organization, which are unliked in saking scient to accelerate clean growth and climate protection through the rapid phase out of traditional coal power. We commit to exhibiting that phase out in a sustainable and economically includes way, while providing appropriate support for workers and.

MORE SPECIFICALL

 Covernment partners commit to phasing out existing traditional coal power and placing a moratorium on any new traditional coal power stations without operational carbon capture and storage, within our jurisdictions.

 Business and other non-government partners commit to powering their operations without coal.

All partners commit to supporting clean power through their policies (whether public or corporate, as appropriate) and investments and restricting financing for traditional coal power stations without operational carbon capture and


To support these goals, the partners in Powering Past Coal will work together to share real-world examples and best practices to support the phase-out of coal, including through climate financing, and adopt practical initiatives that support this transition, including developing clean-energy plans and targets.

We will also encourage our peers to join us in powering past coal to build better world for our children and grandchildren.

As founding partners, we will work to grow the alliance to 50 partners by the 24th session of the Conference of the Parties to continue the momentur towards a safer climate, healthier people, and a cleaner economy.

Powering Past Coal Alliance Objectives



The first **government** driven platform to facilitate coal phase-out:

- Assist partners in implementing commitments while working to increase the number of coal phase-out commitments;
- Provide a forum for peer-to-peer knowledge, best practices, and solutions sharing, climate financing guidance and capacity building;
- 3. Engage in international coal advocacy and diplomacy; and
- 4. **Promote** the positive economic results that come with the transition from 'coal to clean'.

- 2 new government partners; 4 new organizations
- Launch of joint work with Bloomberg Philanthropies on case-studies and research to support and promote coal phase-out





Next Steps for the PPCA

- Working Level Meeting in Berlin, June 2018
- Continue to grow the PPCA through 2018
- Increase financial sector participation including mobilizing philanthropic finance
- Advance efforts in Just Transition for workers and communities
